

DISCOVERY

Beautiful Bari. Step inside the 11th-century Basilica of St. Nicholas, stroll by beautiful churches in Old Town and explore the Murat Quarter.

Wonders of Polignano a Mare. This tiny village rises dramatically from craggy limestone cliffs. Admire the medieval Marchesale Arch, and weave through the Old Town's cobbled streets.

Barocco Lecce. Lecce's 17th-century structures display beautiful caryatids and lyrical scrolls. Visit Piazza Sant'Oronzo, view the Roman amphitheater and see the Basilica di Santa Croce.

White City of Ostuni. Admire the famous whitewashed buildings that blanket Ostuni's hilltop perch, and take in sweeping coastal vistas in Old Town.

Trani, the Pearl of Apulia. Admire this ancient seaport's 12th-century cathedral and view Norman houses that line the Jewish Ghetto's polished cobblestone streets.

Meet the People. Tour a family-run olive mill, sample the freshly pressed oils and enjoy lunch. Gather with locals for a discussion about their life in Italy.

Trulli Fascinating Alberobello. Discover Alberobello's enigmatic trulli dwellings, which dot the countryside.

Locorotondo. Journey to medieval Locorotondo, where gleaming white buildings swirl down a hilltop setting.

Sassi di Matera. Venture into Matera's celebrated sassi cave dwellings. These prehistoric caverns and churches are carved into the soft calcareous rock straddling both sides of a steep ravine.

History and Architecture of Lecce and Ostuni. Explore southern Italy's rich architectural heritage, focusing on Lecce, "The Florence of the South," and Ostuni, the "White City."

Contemporary Italy. Examine Italy's cultural heritage as it's reflected today, and compare southern Apulia's slower-paced lifestyle with that of its more industrialized northern counterpart.
