TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

- Depart the U.S. for Calgary, Canada with time to explore the city. Visit the famed Prince of Wales Hotel and take in beautiful Upper Waterton Lake views in the Canadian Rockies before crossing back into the U.S. to explore majestic Glacier National Park.
- Board legendary "Red Jammers" – sightseeing buses with roll-back convertible tops. Ride along the Going-to-the-Sun Road, taking in the breathtaking scenery. Head into the forest for a leisurely three-mile hike along the Whitefish Trail, then visit Whitefish Mountain Resort, a popular ski area where you board chairlifts to the top of the mountain and visit Summit Nature Center.
- Cross back into Canada and enter world-famous Banff National Park, ascending to Lake Louise, where your hotel is located.
- Depart via the Columbia Icefields Parkway for the drive to the 125-square-mile Columbia Icefields in Banff National Park, a UNESCO site. Board the *Ice Explorer* all-terrain vehicle for the ride to Athabasca Glacier, the most visited glacier in North America. Disembark and explore before departing for Jasper National Park, another UNESCO site. View Maligne Canyon and Maligne Lake, where you take a morning cruise.
- Experience the Columbia Icefields Parkway again, and tiptoe across the Glacier Skywalk. Ride aboard the Banff Gondola to the top of Sulphur Mountain, then travel Tunnel Mountain Road to two more natural wonders: the HooDoos and Bow Falls. Celebrate your outdoor adventures with a farewell dinner before transferring to the Calgary airport for your flight back to the U.S.

***PLEASE NOTE:** At this time, elements of the tour are still being finalized. Your deposit will be fully refundable until all details, including pricing, are complete. Single travelers please add \$1,295*. *Please note: This trip involves considerable walking on uneven terrain in a natural environment. You should be in good physical condition to enjoy the tour to its fullest. A Note about Altitude:* Elevations at hotel locations are not severe, ranging from 3,400 ft. to 5,200 ft. The relatively high altitude reached on two excursions – Columbia Icefields (9,800 ft.) and Going-to-the-Sun Road (6,700 ft.) could pose problems for guests with certain health conditions. You should consult your personal physician if you have concerns.

PLEASE NOTE: All dates, prices, and itinerary details for 2018 tours are subject to change. Finalized pricing will be made available approximately eight months prior to departure.
