ITINERARY IN BRIEF

TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

Days 1-4: March 29-April 1, 2018
Depart U.S./Auckland

- Arrive in cosmopolitan Auckland and take a walking tour of New Zealand's largest city. Visit the Auckland museum with its prized collection of Maori art, and embark on a cruise around glittering Auckland Harbour.

Days 5-7: April 2-4, 2018
Rotorua/Napier

- En route to Rotorua, stop to see the unique glowworms that illuminate Ruakuri Caves. Visit Rotorua's Te Puia Thermal Reserve and Maori Cultural Centre for a traditional *hangi* dinner and performance. Encounter native New Zealand flora and fauna at Rainbow Springs Nature Park. Set out for the celebrated wine region of Hawke's Bay, where you sample local wine at an acclaimed winery. Reaching seaside Napier, take an Art Deco walking tour.

Days 8-10: April 5-7, 2018
Wellington/Christchurch

- Stop at a farm on the way to Wellington to enjoy a sheep-shearing demonstration and watch sheep dogs at work. In New Zealand's capital, enjoy a ride on the historic Wellington Cable Car and visit renowned Te Papa, the national museum. Fly south to Christchurch where highlights include the Botanic Gardens, Cathedral Square, and vibrant "Re:START Mall."

Days 11-12: April 8-9, 2018
Franz Josef Glacier

- Embark on one of the world's great rail journeys aboard the Tranz-Alpine train, traveling above deep gorges and through tunnels. Board a motorcoach for the scenic drive to Franz Josef. Encounter Franz Josef Glacier, one of New Zealand's most spectacular sights, on a walk through the glacial valley. Visit the West Coast Wildlife Centre with its rare kiwi birds.

Days 13-15: April 10-12, 2018
Queenstown

- Stop in Wanaka for lunch then in the Gibbston Valley Vineyard for a private tasting and tour before reaching Queenstown. Enjoy a full-day excursion to Fjordland National Park, including a catamaran cruise in enchanting Doubtful Sound, one of New Zealand's top attractions. Enjoy the outdoor mecca of Queenstown as you wish with a day at leisure, followed by a farewell dinner to celebrate your adventure.

Day 16: April 13, 2018
Depart Queenstown for U.S.

- Depart this morning for the airport and your return flight home.
