## TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

- Tour Ba Dinh Square, the Presidential Palace, the granite mausoleum of Ho Chi Minh and the thousand-year-old One Pillar Pagoda. Walk the narrow streets of the Ancient Quarter. Enjoy a full day excursion to Ha Long Bay including a boat ride and seafood lunch.
- Tour the Cham Museum with artifacts dating from the 7<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> centuries. Visit Hoi An, a colorful village where many ancient traditions still hold sway. Witness daily life of a local farming community where water buffaloes plow the fields and villagers ride to market with produce piled high on their bicycles.
- Travel to the ancient imperial capital of Hue and visit the Imperial Citadel and the Central Market. Cruise along Hue's Perfume River to the Thien Mu Pagoda, a Buddhist monastery. Visit the Tomb of Minh Mang, modeled after the Ming Tombs of China, and the tombs of Tu Doc and colorful Khai Dinh.
- Fly to Saigon, then travel south to the Mekong River town of Cai Be, then on to the provincial capital of Can Tho. Journey by boat to the floating market at Cai Rang on the Mekong's lower reaches. Enjoy an afternoon of independent exploration.
- Board a motorized sampan for an introduction to river life on the upper reaches of the storied Mekong. In Saigon, tour the former Presidential Palace and the History Museum, and attend a traditional water puppet performance. Explore the Cu Chi Tunnels, and enjoy a farewell dinner.
- Following a day at leisure for independent exploration, depart late in the evening for an overnight flight to the U.S.
