Dates, program details and tour costs, although given in good faith and based on tariffs, and other information current at the time of printing are subject to change at or before the time of departure. No revisions of the printed itinerary or its included features are anticipated; however, the right is reserved to make any changes, with or without notice, with the mutual understanding that any additional expenses will be paid by the individual participant. Baggage and personal effects are the sole responsibility of the owners at all times. The right to accept or to refuse any person as a member of this trip at any time, when such action is determined by Tufts University to be in the best interests of the health, safety, or general welfare of the tour group or of the individual, subject only to the requirement that that the portion of the total amount paid which corresponds to the unused services and accommodations be refunded. If the entire program is cancelled for any reason, participants shall have no claim other than for a full refund.
